This recently extended and refurbished retreat centre in the heart of Warwickshire, is set in 7 acres of beautiful grounds with mature trees.



It can accommodate 60 people, 27 of these in the new annexe with en-suite rooms. Tea and coffee making facilities are available in bedrooms.

Whilst dining on the good, wholesome cooking you can enjoy restful views of the grounds and wildlife.

There are several meeting rooms, two with the latest audio visual equipment.

Other facilities include a lounge, games room, quiet room, craft room, library, book shop and conservatory.



The Centre has full access for those less able bodied, including en-suite accommodation with two purpose built wet rooms.
